

YOUR SECOND CHANCE! TO "KNOCK OUT POLIO"

STATEMENT BY Participating Doctors

Type I polio has now been dealt a body blow in Southwestern Idaho and Eastern Oregon. The enthusiasm and response as evidenced by over 60,000 oral immunizations given by Type I has indicated to the medical profession that the people are enthusiastic and look forward to even larger numbers (from all the calls we have received) to the second mass immunization to knock out TYPE II polio.

Its safety record is unequalled, and we might point out here that the Sabin vaccine has been given the full go-ahead by the Canadian Government after re-evaluation of this

vaccine, following investigation of the immunizations given in the past six months.

Since our last immunization of Type I, Nov. 3-4, millions of doses have been given throughout the country, and all previous records have been broken as to the number of people receiving it.

The Southwestern Idaho Medical Society and the Malheur County Medical Association, whose members are listed below, know that this second offering, which will be TYPE II, will be received with even more enthusiasm than the last offering, which was Type I.
