NASA Spokesmen Give Demonstration

(From the Nyssa High Bulldog) Bob McCurdy and Jerri Ochab, representatives from NASA, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, presented a general assembly Feb. 12 in the gym.

Starting with the space flight of the Ancient Greeks, McCurdy traced the history of space travel illustrating his story with different experiments.

McCurdy explained and demonstrated modern-day achievements. Among these were the moon flight equipment, the scale model rockets and Microminiaturization, the process of making objects smaller and better. For example, the 1959 computer that McCurdy demonstrated was reduced from about 12 x 15 inches to the size of a pencil point.

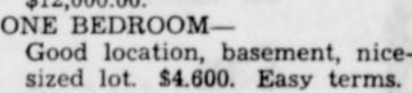
