Attending the University of Idaho in Moscow will be Mrs. Witty and Bowen; Quinowski is traveling to Washington, D.C. Requirements for Mrs. Witty's scholarship were that she should have required hours of Spanish, teaching experience and recommendations from competent people. The scholarship is given under the National Defense Education Act and is designed to promote greater proficiency in teaching and using the language. This will be the second year of a three-year scholarship for Bowen. The scholarship is sponsored by the National Science Foundation and leads to Bowen's master's degree in the field of natural science. Bowen will be studying ornithology, mammology and systematic botany. Classes for Mrs. Witty and Bowen will last eight weeks. The registration date is June 17. Quinowski received a Neuberger scholarship to Washington, D.C. He will attend a five-week seminar in the nation's capital and will study for one week at New York. Two teachers from the state of Oregon were selected to receive the scholarship. A BARBECUE is always a fun way to entertain. Nowadays, many ranges — gas or electric — are equipped with rotisseries.
