NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the school district bond election hereby called, to be held at the Elementary School Building, in and for School District No. 61 of Malheur County, Oregon, on Monday, the 8th day of February, A.D. 1965, between the hours of 2 p.m. and 8 p.m., Mountain Standard Time, there will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of contracting a bonded indebtedness in the sum of \$135,000.00 for the purpose of providing funds with which to construct, reconstruct, improve, equip and furnish school buildings and additions thereto and to acquire all personal property appurtenant thereto or connected therewith in and for said school district.

The vote shall be by ballot, upon which shall be the words "Bonds . . . Yes" and "Bonds . . . No," and the voter shall place a cross (X) between the word "Bonds" and the word "Yes," or between the word "Bonds" and the word "No," whichever indicates his choice.
