MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE MALHEUR COUNTY COURT - JULY 7, 1965

Called to order by County Judge Ellis A. White with Commissioners Earl Flock and Jacob Fischer present. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The County Court adopted the resolution to request urban planning assistance of an over-all program for future community development, the preservation of community values, the prevention of conditions tending to cause urban blight, and the promotion of the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the county.
