Work Smarter . . . Not Harder

BRIDES, IF YOUR HUSBANDS SHIRTS

are made of a blend of cotton and polyester fiber, you may notice they are turning yellow. Can they be made white again?

Sometimes they can be improved, but not always. To the woman who asked us this question, we suggested that she soak shirts in one of the blue liquid laundry detergents, using its full strength. These products contain a brightener which is claimed to be effective on polyester. The woman called back to tell us it worked for her.

This may not always be successful. You can also try machine washing in very hot water—too hot for hands. Also, add chlorine bleach. Hot water causes the fabric to be more wrinkled and it will need some touch-up ironing, but the whiteness may be improved.

A "WELL-SEASONED" HOMEMAKER
we visited in a retirement home recently had about a dozen cardboard tubes from rolls of paper towels piled up in her kitchen.

She slips them over a clothes line when she washes and dries blankets so there is not a sharp crease from the line after the blanket is dry.

Another way, of course, is to dry the blanket over two or three parallel lines.
