**Ronnie McCain Takes Navy Training Course At San Diego Station**

Seaman Recruit Ronnie V. McCain, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Vernon N. McCain of route 1, Nyssa, is undergoing seven weeks of basic training at the Naval Training Center in San Diego, according to a Navy news release.

Under supervision of veteran Navy petty officers, he is receiving instructions in naval history and organization, customs and courtesies, ordnance and gunnery, seamanship, damage control, first aid, swimming and survival, ship-board drills and sentry duty.

Military drills are emphasized during recruit training, and with various inspections and a planned physical fitness program, keep the recruits mentally and physically alert.

Upon completion of recruit training, he will be assigned to a school, shore station or ship, according to results of his Navy classification tests, his own desires and the needs of the Navy.
