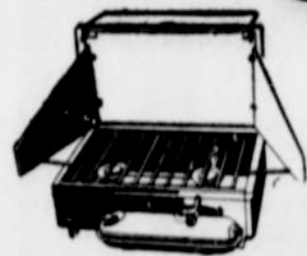
NYSSA SOLDIER TRAINS AT BASE IN CALIFORNIA

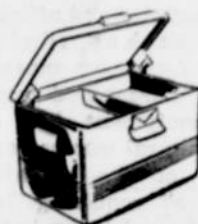
