

Personal Articles, Bee Boards Stolen From Area Residents

At press time Wednesday, the Malheur Sheriff's department was still investigating two recent thefts in the area, according to Deputy Sheriff Dick Pounds of Nyssa.

A quantity of jewelry, clothing, transistor and clock radios were reported stolen between 9 a.m. and noon last Thursday from the Larry Nielson farm near Cairo junction.

Entry to the residence was made by prying off a screen at the rear of the house during the owners' absence.

Approximately \$600 worth of filled leaf cutter bee boards were taken last Thursday evening from the fields of LeRoy Bair on route 2, Nyssa. Jay Gibson, a neighbor, also reported the loss of two boards. He said two others were left on the roadway, making it appear that the thieves had been frightened away.

Pounds stated that due to lack of identification marks on the boards, or the fact that marks are easily removed, the boards are difficult items to track down. He urges all farmers to keep a close watch for strange vehicles or persons near their premises.

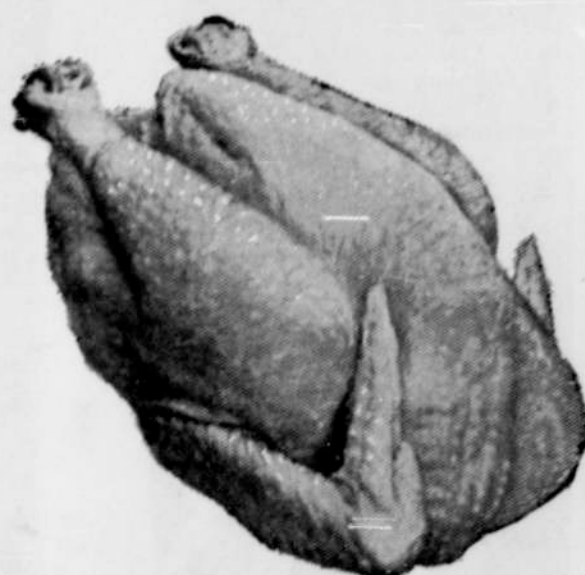

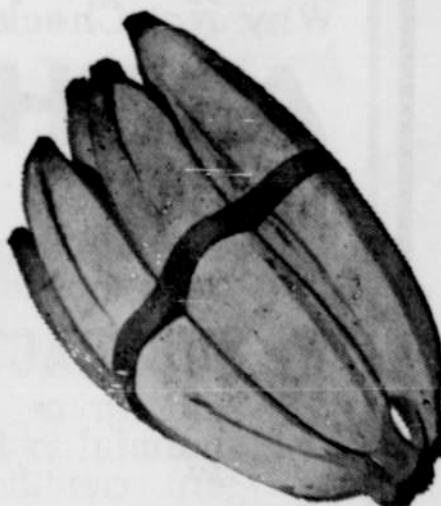
