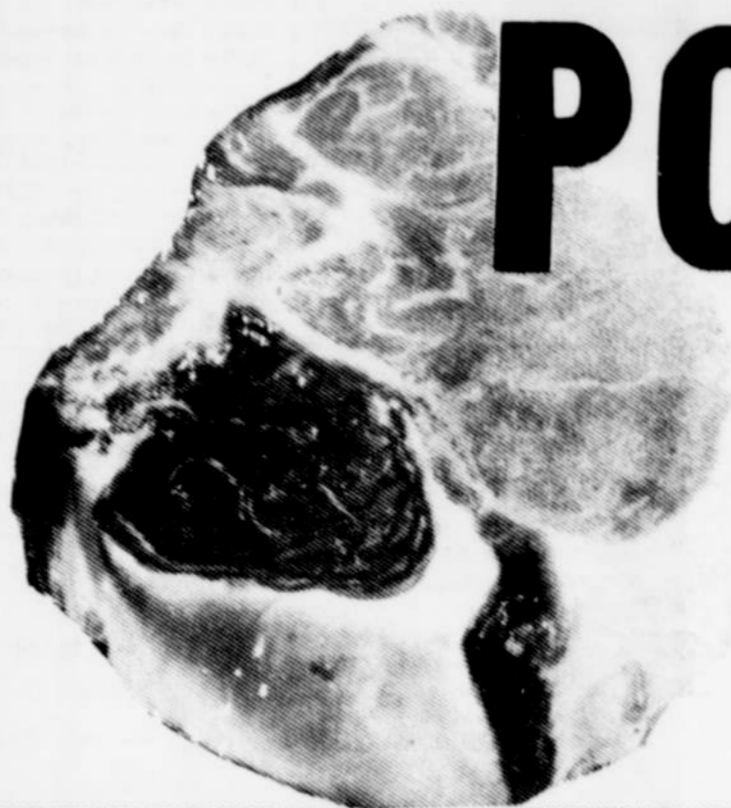
cases of kidnapping, car theft rings, bank robbery and espionage/subversive matters.
