The Adrian hoopsters, last week, came up with two losses and one win, as they gave their Jan. 9 game to Harper, lost a

The Jan. 9 Baker-B league tilt ended with a 52-48 final tally and was Harper's 31st consecutive conference win.

On Saturday evening, the local lads bowed 69-44 to the visiting Falcons from Vallive.

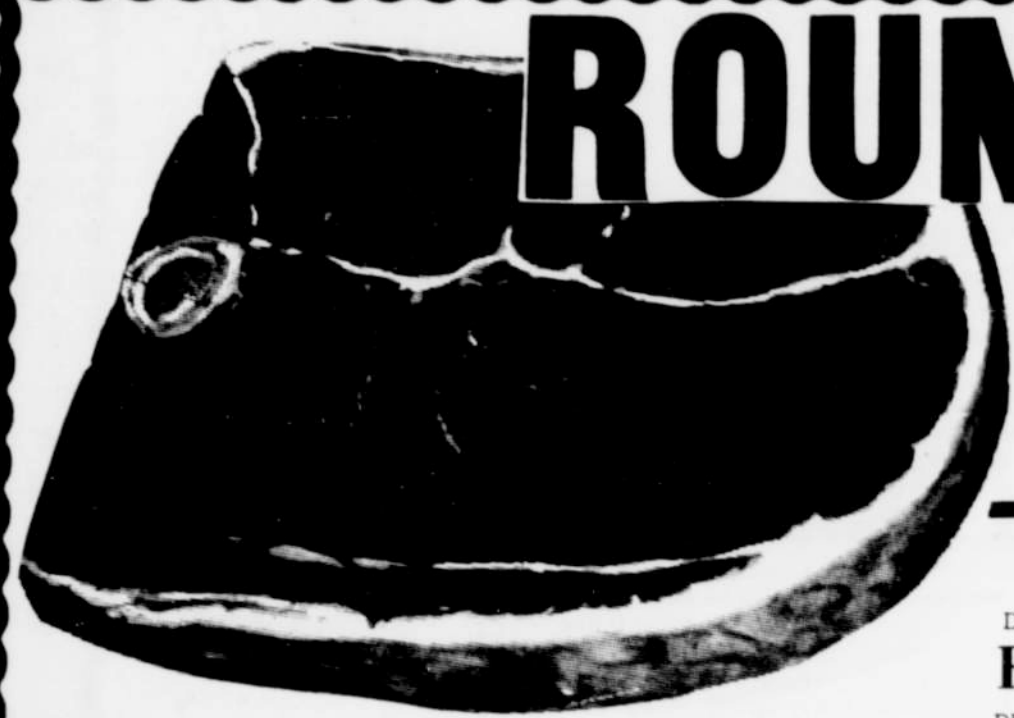
Payette's Mitchell Stanton was top man Friday evening, as he tossed 21 counters through the rings to help clinch the Pirates' first SRV-A win of the season.
