At the Feb. 23 meeting a discussion of different soups was held. The members made potato soup. - Betty Jo Wenke, reporter.

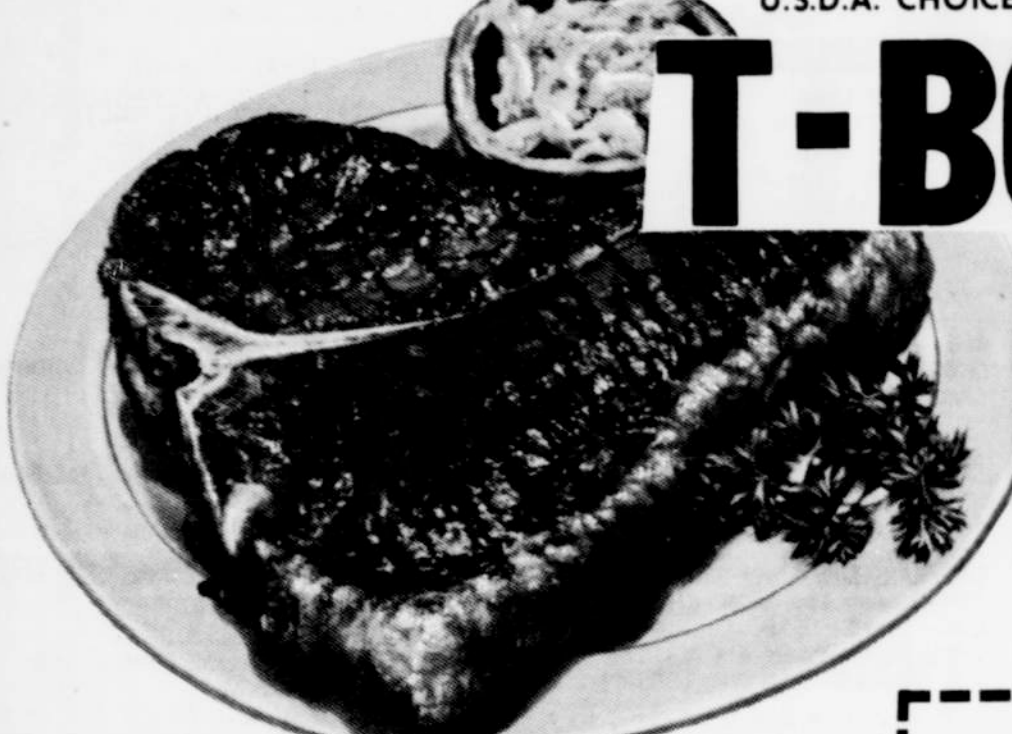
STITCH AND SEW CLUB
