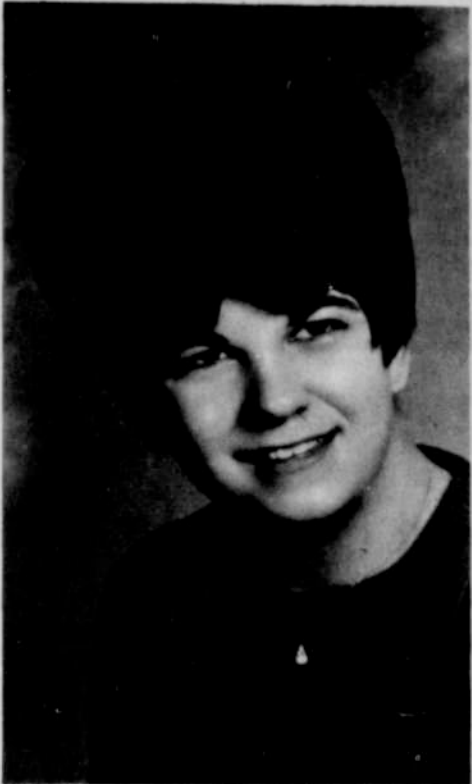




LINDA MECHAM
