TVCC Plans Classes On Soils, Pest Control

Two special classes are being prepared at Treasure Valley Community college for fieldmen responsible for chemical applications. 'Soils' is designed to include some basic soil science but will emphasize soil fertility and fertilizer materials. The companion course, 'Pest Control,' will have major emphasis on the chemistry of pest control materials. Those needing to comply with USDA and other agency regulations will find this class of value. Agriculture chemical applicators will be able to meet requirements for Oregon State applicators' examinations. 'Soils' will begin on Tuesday, Jan. 7 and 'Pest Control' will start on Thursday, Jan. 9. Each course will include 30 class hours with the schedule running from 7 to 10 p. m. Those wishing to register for either class or both, may do so on the first class day, according to Bill Murphy, technical agriculture instructor at TVCC, or they may enroll at the college's continuing education office.

Nyssa Schools Pick Members Of Committee

Two members of the budget committee of the Nyssa school district were elected recently, it was reported by Clerk Dirick Nedry. New board members who will work with the school board on the 1969-70 budget are Cyrus Bock and John Studer. Both men will serve a three-year term and are replacing Gene DeMinck, who has moved from the area and Roy Holmes, whose term has expired. Nedry said the 1968 school census just completed revealed 2,072 students in the district between the ages of 4 and 19. This is up 216 students from the last census. An agreement was enacted between the Nyssa and Fruitland school boards whereby two Fruitland district students, living on an island in the Snake River, will attend Nyssa high school. The Fruitland district will pay the tuition.
