MINUTES OF THE MALHEUR COUNTY COURT MEETING - NOVEMBER 6, 1968

Called to order by County Judge Ellis A. White with Commissioners Jacob Fischer and E. W. Maag present.

AGREED to insulate a storage room in the basement for the Jail's food supply.

APPOINTED Richard Scott as Malheur County's Civil Defense director.

Louis Pratt submitted his resignation as a member of the Farm Labor Housing Committee. The Court will appoint a replacement at a later date.

The Court signed a Contract Cancellation, whereas J. H. Daniels had purchased a parcel of land at the Sheriff's Tax Sale advertised as "6 acres more or less" but after being surveyed, only contained "1/2 acre more or less". The County declared the sale void and returned the down payment.

The County signed an agreement between the State of Oregon and City of Ontario, for the purpose of the outdoor recreation project known as Aiken Park.
