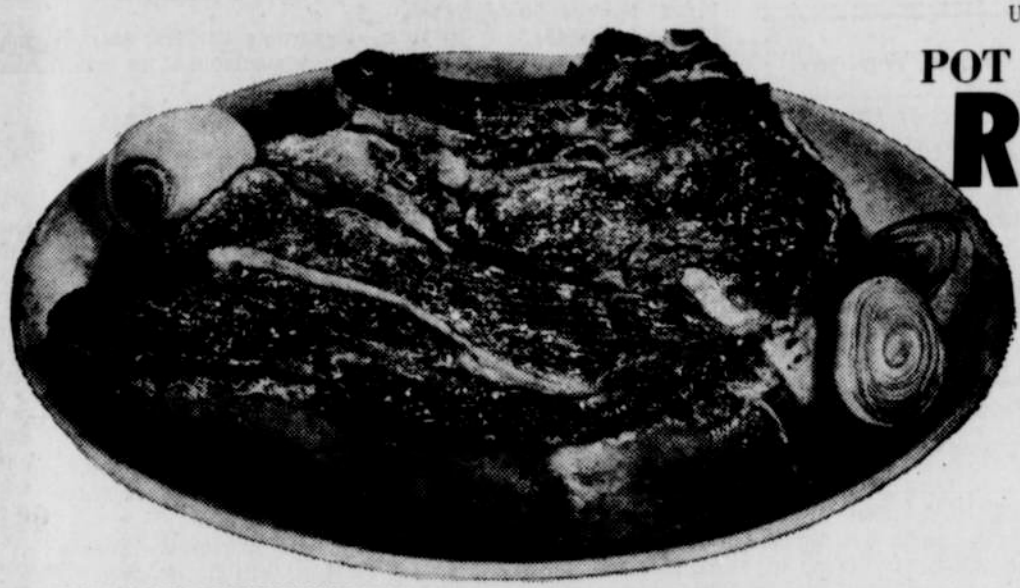
a 30 day leave he will report to Fort Benning, Georgia. Eldon was in the service a year before going to Vietnam.
