

## ULLMAN ANNOUNCES PLAN TO FILE FOR EIGHTH CONGRESSIONAL TERM

Congressman Al Ullman, announcing plans to seek reelection from Oregon's Second Congressional District, said today he would be proud to serve "as the nation begins to confront the great economic and social challenges of the Seventies."

Ullman, who has represented the District since 1957, said, "The new decade offers a real chance to reduce and eliminate some of the major threats to our way of life--economic instability, environmental pollution, poverty, and inadequate housing, health care and educational opportunities."

The Second District Congressman said, "I will always consider the first priority of business to be solutions to the problems of my constituents. Equally important is the development of the water, land and timber resources of my district."

"The great potential of public lands in the district for recreational uses must be realized. The spectacular scenery and heritage of the past must be preserved," he added.

"However," Ullman said, "the 1970's bring added challenges. The issues are critical. Above all, the cost of living--of food, a new car, medical care--must be brought under control. Prices are still rising more rapidly than they have since the early 1950's. At the same time, growing unemployment is spreading through the economy."

Ullman added, "elsewhere, tight money and high interest rates are eroding away all the social and economic gains of the past decade. We have a housing crisis--only half of the new houses we need are under construction. We have a recession in our lumber economy. In Oregon, prices are down sharply and more than 50 miles are closed or operating on a part-time basis."

He continued, "Welfare, crime, education all need top attention. A sensible farm policy that recognizes the special problems of farm income must be adopted. Tax relief for state and local governments must be found if power is really to flow back to the people. "In short, we need to reorder our priorities. This means eliminating wasteful and unnecessary spending. Grossly expensive and highly questionable

### Oregonians Eat Near Ton Of Food Annually

Ever wonder how much food you eat per year? Well, hang on to your calorie counter because the Agri-Business Council says the average Oregonian eats nearly three-quarters of a ton every year.

This means that farmers produce about 1.5 million tons of food each year just to feed the people living in Oregon.

Now, have you ever wondered how many different kinds of food you eat during the year? According to the council, the average modern supermarket is stocked with 8,000 or more good selling items.

Most people, as they wheel their shopping carts from one section of the supermarket to the other, probably take this variety of products for granted. The people who don't take it for granted are the farmers.

Production of all this food is not determined by some central agency. In Oregon, it is the result of 41,000 sets of decisions made by 41,000 farmers. It is they who decide what crops to grow, and how many acres of each to plant.

Interestingly enough, Oregon today produces a larger quantity of food, better quality food, and many more products to choose from than were produced in 1950 but with 21,600 fewer farms.

Today's farmer is larger, more specialized and more mechanized than his predecessor. And quite possibly, tomorrow's farmer will determine planting and harvesting schedules off a printout from a computer center. His automated machinery will be directed by tape-controlled programs. And, robot harvesters will carry out high speed picking, grading, packaging and freezing.

And this will all be done to provide every person in Oregon with his yearly supply of three-quarters of a ton of food.
