Stock Market Comes to Life in New Film

Trading on the 19th century Curb Market - predecessor to the American Stock Exchange - took place outdoors, no matter what the weather. Hundreds of brokers gathered on the streets of downtown New York, waving and shouting to telephone clerks perched in windows above the street. To be recognized in the crowd, brokers wore bizarre clothing like yellow hornburgs and striped jackets. The buying and selling of securities became so noisy that traders developed a system of hand signals to communicate. Modern Marketplace The Amex today bears little resemblance to its 19th century ancestor. The hurly-burly of the old Outdoor Curb has been replaced by a public interest emphasis on self-regulation and automation. Floor officials on the American Exchange Trading Floor oversee the public marketplace. Stock Watch personnel monitor trading. Computer technicians operate electronic equipment. Educational Film Both faces of the Amex - its colorful history and today's streamline marketplace - now come to life in a new 22-minute color film. "The Investor and the Marketplace." Performers in present-day sequences are the actual Trading Floor personnel and behind-the-scenes individuals who make the Amex work.
