

## GOLDEN TOUCH OF HOSPITALITY BY JANE ASHLEY Sauce Good Hot or Cold

Horseradish, a fimiliar condiment used with meats, provides the pungent flavor for this sause. Use it hot for main dishes, cold for sandwiches, or cold meat plates.

### Horseradish Sauce tablespoon corn starch 1/4 cup fresh bread crumbs

1 cup milk 1 (4-ounce) bottle horseradish 1/2 teaspoon salt

Dash pepper Mix corn starch and bread crumbs in medium saucepan. Gradually stir in milk. Cook

over medium heat, stirring constantly until mixture comes to a boil and boils one minute Remove from heat and stir in horseradish, salt and pepper. Reheat gently or chill. Makes 11/2 cups. Note: If thinner consistency

is desired, stir in extra milk.
