Door prizes were won by Mrs. Charles Mann and Mrs. Carl Burningham.

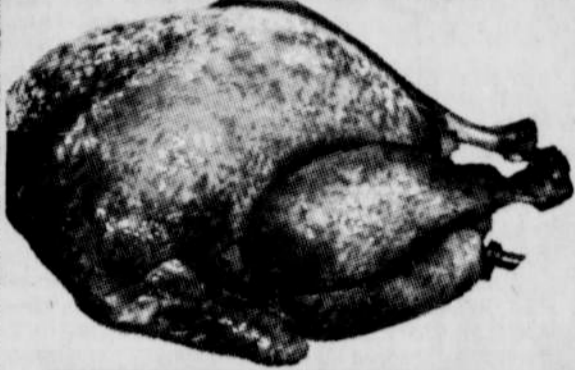

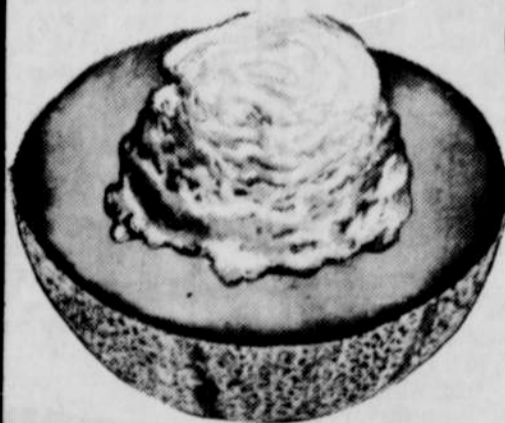
