### Dr. Sontag C of I Speaker

Dr. Frederick E. Sontag, a professor of philosophy at Pomona College, will deliver the College of Idaho convocation address Jan. 29 as part of his week's visit on campus as guest lecturer in a winter session philosophy seminar Jan. 25-29.

The 9:30 a.m. address in the Grover M. Hermann Lecture Auditorium of Boone Science is open to the public and will be on a chapter theme from a book on American thought he now has in preparation. The topic for his address is "The American Experience and the Future of Religion."

Dr. Sontag, a personal friend of C of I President Warren B. Knox, earned degrees from Stanford and Yale Universities and was previously an instructor at Yale. He was chairman of the coordinating committee in philosophy at Claremont Graduate School and University Center from 1962-65; chairman of the department of philosophy at Pomona College 1960-67; and chairman of the committee on honors study from 1961-70.

Dr. Sontag is a prolific author, and, in addition to numerous professional articles, has completed ten book length manuscripts, eight of which have been published or are on schedule for publication.
