Stardusters OES met May 10 at the home of Myra Atherton, her mother Mrs. Noah assisted. There were 17 members present.

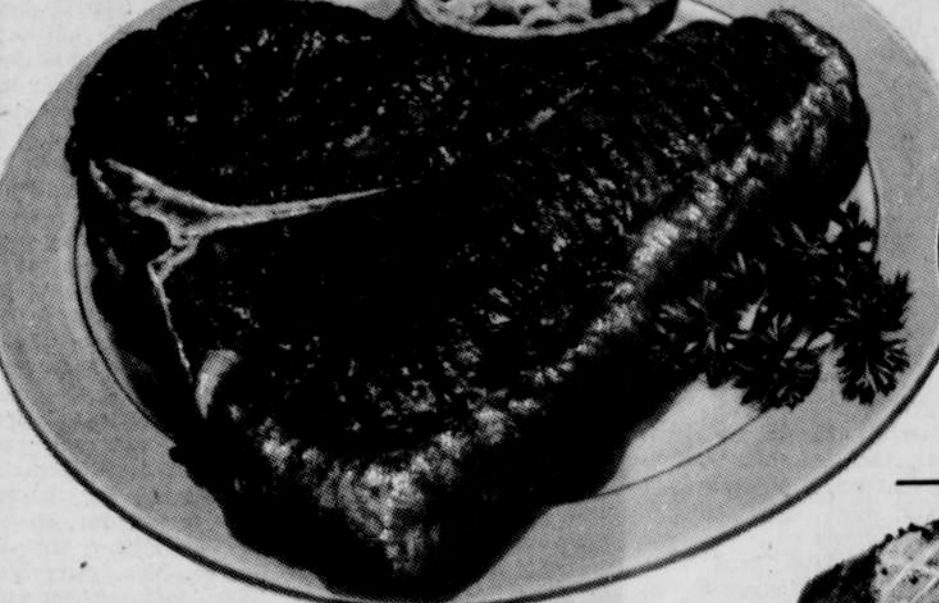

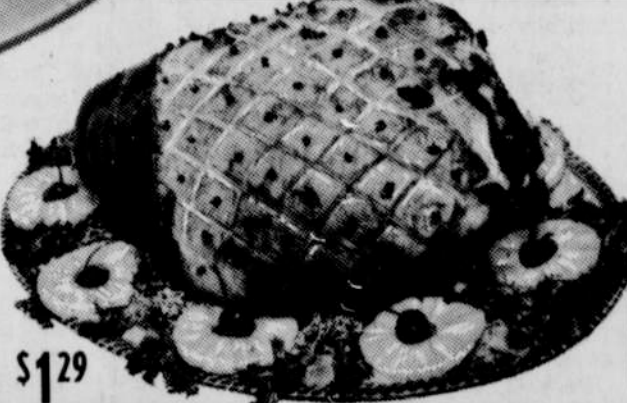
