Highway Death Toll Down

Fifty-four people died in Oregon traffic during May, the same number as killed during that month a year ago, according to the Motor Vehicles Division. Even so, the state's five month death toll still shows improvement over 1970 with 236 fatalities reported, compared with 256 for that period last year.

The agency said the next three months will be critical in determining if Oregon will record a decrease in traffic deaths this year, as it did in 1970.
