Ruth Ann is a 1969 Nyssa High School graduate and has attended Oregon State University in Corvallis for two years majoring in Home Economics Communications.

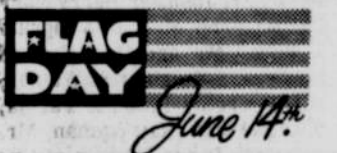
Graduates Receive Scholarship Awards
