Notice is hereby given that the Oregon State Highway Commission has proposed plans for a future project on the Snake River (Adrian) Bridge Section of the Parma Spur Highway, lying near the community of Adrian, Malheur County, Oregon.

The proposal consists of revision of the existing alignment to provide a new structure 40 feet in width over the Snake River with adjacent road section of 12-foot travel lanes and 8-foot shoulders. The project is approximately 0.13 miles in length.
