Empire Builders Plan Clean-up

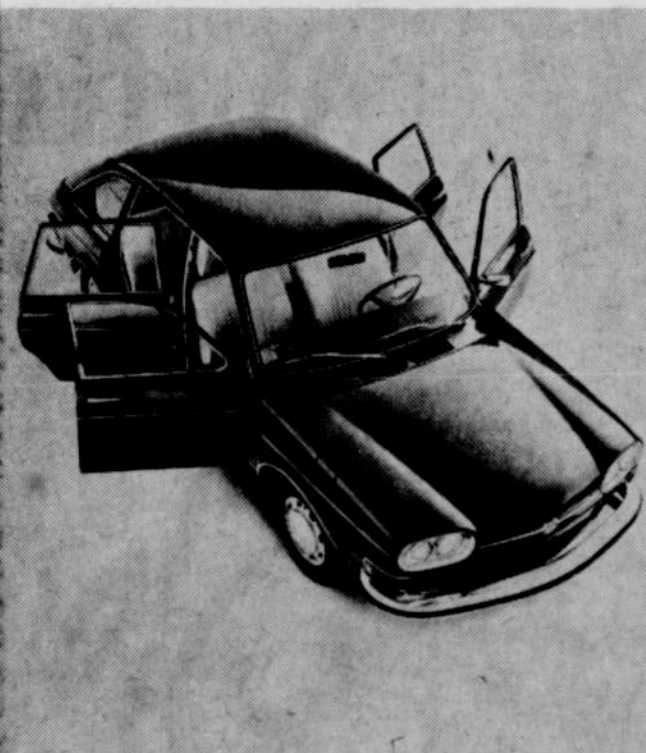
