Ullman Says Farmers Feel Economic Squeeze

The American farmer is being squeezed harder than ever, Congressman Al Ullman said Thursday when the latest Bureau of Labor statistics showed a 2.2 percent drop in farm product prices.

"Farm product prices plunged while feed and equipment prices rose again," Ullman said "and the result is a serious cost squeeze for farmers."

Noting President Nixon's statement earlier this week that he would not reject out-of-hand the idea of a government board to suggest national wage and price standards, Ullman also co-sponsored legislation Thursday to set up such a board.

The measure would create a temporary Emergency Guidance Board to facilitate economic recovery and minimize inflation by establishing price and wage guidelines.

The President has flatly rejected mandatory wage and price controls, but he said this week he would consider a board to establish guidelines if congressional hearings convinced him government pressure to influence wages and prices could work "without stifling the economy."

Ullman said he hopes hearings on the bill he co-sponsored, which seeks voluntary adherence to guidelines established by the emergency board, would help convince President Nixon to take action.

A group of Republican senators submitted similar legislation on the Senate side earlier in the week.

When Ullman introduced a bill to create wage and price guidelines earlier this year he said it would be farsighted of the administration to put it into effect. "Now it has become a necessity," he said.
