Governor McCall Appoints Members To Health Board

Governor Tom McCall announced today that he has appointed eight new members and reappointed six to serve on the reorganized Oregon State Board of Health.

New appointees to the state health agency's policy-making body are:
Gene Kanagy, Lebanon, administrator of Lebanon Community Hospital, a past president of the Oregon Association of Hospitals; for six years, a member of the advisory council for Oregon's Hill-Burton grant program.

Dr. Donald F. Kelly, Portland pediatrician; currently secretary-treasurer of the Oregon Medical Association and vice-president of the Multnomah County Medical Society.
Mrs. Margaret A. Quan, Portland, registered nurse, formerly on the Multnomah County Health Department staff; chairman of the program and public relations committee for District 1, Oregon Nurses' Association; member of the ONA committee on government relations.

Dr. Noel B. Rawls, Astoria, Clatsop County Health Officer; past president of the Oregon Medical Association; since 1959, a member of the OMA Board of Trustees.

Dr. Richard C. Reed, Portland optometrist; past president of the Oregon Optometric Association; a member of the State Board of Optometry for nine years; named Oregon Optometrist of the Year for 1967.

Verne C. Reiersen, Portland, director of the Center for Public Health Studies, Portland State University; former chief of Environmental Sanitation Services, Oregon State Board of Health, 1954-1965; current president of the National Environmental Health Association; past president of the Western Branch, American Public Health Association.

Dr. Wilfred W. Taylor, Portland chiropractic physician; a former member of the Advisory Committee to the Oregon State Board of Health; past president of Naturopathic Physicians.

Joe Y. Saito, Ontario rancher, served on the State Board of Agriculture for nine years; trustee, Treasure Valley Community College; past president and member of the board of Malheur County Onion Growers Association.

The governor's reappointments to the Board of Health are:
Edward M. Anderson, Eugene laundry service operator, elected president of the formerly constituted Board of Health in January, 1971; Dr. Frederic H. Bentley, Lincoln City, surgeon and medical director of North Lincoln Hospital; Dr. Daniel B. Bone, Eugene osteopathic physician and surgeon; Dr. Arthur Huber, Astoria dentist; Conrad N. McConnell, Portland, chief pharmacist at St. Vincent Hospital; and Dr. Beatrice K. Rose, Portland physician.

Lloyd Hammel, chairman of the Comprehensive Health Planning Authority will also hold a position on the 15-member board.

State Public Health Officer Edward Press will continue to serve as secretary of the Board ex-officio.

House Bill 1060, passed by the recent Legislative Assembly enlarged the board by four and called for broader representation from the health-related occupations. In addition to the professions of physician, dentist and pharmacist which have been long represented in its membership, the Board of Health now includes a district or county health officer, a registered nurse, a sanitarian, and an optometrist.

Two members must be persons licensed as administrators of general hospitals, nursing home administrators, podiatrists, chiropractors, naturopaths, veterinarians or masseurs.

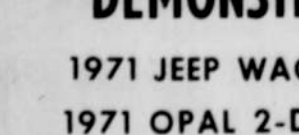
