Oregon's Traffic

Death Toll Up

October was a record breaking month on Oregon streets and highways.

The Motor Vehicles Division reports that 77 people died in traffic during the month, making it the worst October on record in the state. One head-on crash killed nine people, also establishing a new record as the worst accident involving private passenger cars in the state's history.

The October death toll shoved the state's record for the year to 587, compared with 567 for the same period a year ago.

An agency spokesman reminded that the state is now entering an extremely hazardous time of the year. Bad driving conditions, combined with added hours of darkness and the holiday season that begins late in November generally combine to make November and December the worst months of the year in total accidents and injuries. Traffic deaths in these two months have exceeded 60 in each of the past five years.
