Cooling-off Period: Did you

of your right to cancel the contract or the contract continues to be rescindable until the notice is given. (Excepted are sellers of insurance, farm equipment, and motor vehicles.) If you decide to cancel a contract, it must be done, "in writing," before midnight of the third business day after the buyer signs.

This aspect of consumer protection is included in HB 3037, the consumer bill passed by the 1971 Oregon Legislature. The act contains provisions that enhance the private right of consumers and it also enumerates the major powers of the Attorney General and District Attorneys to provide consumer

One-Step Complaint Service: If you have a consumer complaint -- a defect in a product you have bought, for example -and you cannot get a satisfactory adjustment from the dealer or manufacturer, there is a state consumer agency to help


> Write to the Consumer Services Division, Commerce Building, Salem 97310. Explain your complaint, including all pertinent information. Describe the product or service, time and place of purchase, manufacturer's name and address, nature of the complaint, and your efforts to get satisfaction from the seller and/or the manufacturer. Attach copies of any papers that could help explain the situation.

The Consumer Services Division will refer the letter to the appropriate state or federal agency, or may write the manufacturer asking him to take suitable action.

The agency can help the consumer only if he has a justifiable complaint and can provide adequate information about the transaction. It is the responsibility of the consumer to keep important papers and other records in case he needs them to support a com-




