Predict Sales Rise

The electrical manufacturing industry will ship products valued at \$50.2 billion during 1972, a rise of 5.7 per cent over this year's figure, according to the forecast of Joseph F. Miller, president of the National Electrical Manufacturers Association. "The predictions for next year are expressed in real terms based on 1971 dollars," Mr. Miller added. "In other words our forecast does not reflect any inflationary pressures that may be present in 1972."
