

Buy A Button— Save A Life

"Buy a Button--Help Save a Life!" This is the plea of the Oregon Restaurant and Beverage Association which is sponsoring its second annual statewide project by holding a one day "Coffee Day" on Friday, January 28, by a button sale, to raise money for the Kidney Association of Oregon, to help save the lives of Oregonians suffering from kidney failure.

Bright yellow, red and brown buttons, showing a coffee cup, the identification of the Kidney Association of Oregon, ORBA and "A Gift of Life" are being sold for \$1 each at restaurants throughout the state. Individuals buying and wearing the buttons on Friday, January 28 will be able to have free coffee all day at participating restaurants.

Alan Maxwell, McMinnville, President of the Oregon Restaurant and Beverage Association and Charles V. Elliott, Portland, President of the Kidney Association of Oregon urged the public to support the project by buying buttons at participating restaurants.

POTATOES, ONIONS
LEAD SHIPMENTS

More than two-thirds of Oregon's fresh produce moving to market in December was onions or potatoes.

State-Federal Shipping Point Inspection records show a total of 3,489 cars of fresh produce inspected for market during the month, with 1,256 carlots of them, potatoes and 1,179 carlots, onions.

Area shipping the most produce was the Klamath Basin, which had 950 carlots of potatoes and three carlots of pears. While still the leader in potato shipments, the Klamath area this year is not moving potatoes as fast as a year ago. In December, 1970, that area moved 1,726 carlots of potatoes and the total shipments for that season through December were 5,301 carlots compared with a total of only 2,711 carlots for the same period in 1971.

Close behind the Klamath Basin in fresh produce shipments was Malheur County with 821 carlots all but one of which were onions. The exception was a carlot of apples. Malheur County also had 589 tons of onions inspected for processing.

By commodities the December produce shipments in addition to onions and potatoes were 333 carlots of apples; 116 carlots filberts; 565 carlots pears; 18 carlots walnuts; 18 carlots brine cherries and four carlots miscellaneous produce.
