Ontario Golf

Club Fees Up

Increased rates at the Ontario Municipal Golf Course have been approved by the Ontario Golf Course Board.

Green fees on week days will increase from \$1.75 to \$2 for nine holes and from \$2.50 to \$3 for 18 holes. On weekends and holidays, fees will be increased to \$2.50 and \$3.50.

Season tickets for men will increase from \$95 to \$100; for women they will remain at \$75. For a man and wife they will increase from \$137.50 to \$145. For a man, wife and children under 18 they increase from \$165 to \$175 and for a man and wife with students, under 22, from \$165 to \$190. Clergymen will continue \$50 per season and students remain \$15 per term and \$25 per summer.
Club storage remains at \$10; club care \$15 and personal lockers \$6.
