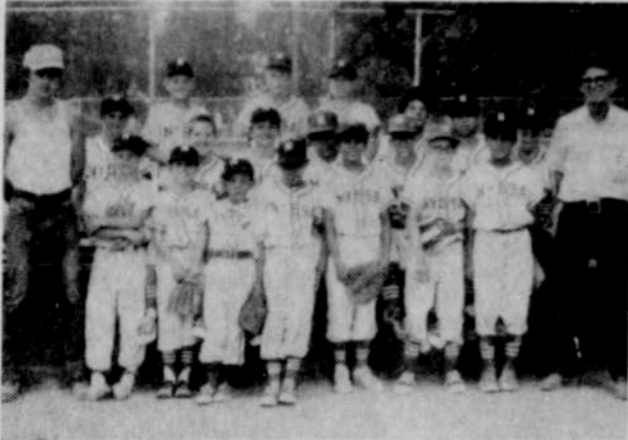

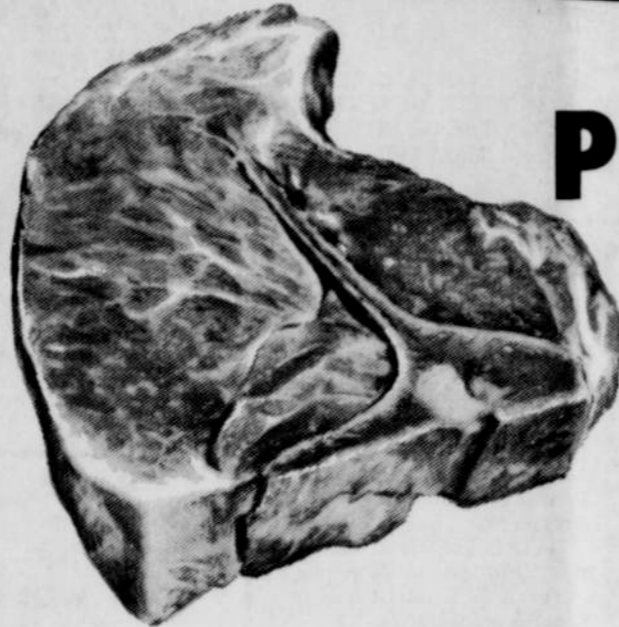
third and Darlene Hamilton, fourth. Following first flight winner, Annie Nelson, was Claire Farber, second while Arlene Richards won third, all of Ontario.
