Jones Warns Restricting Power Plants

Problems faced by livestock producers in Oregon due to the limiting of predator control were cited by Jones. He noted that with previous government predator control programs, numbers of the predators were controlled, but that the local species were never endangered. "If we are not allowed to continue with some form of predator control, we will have real losses in domestic and game range animals," Jones said.

The Commission also discussed other ways in which Idaho may celebrate the two hundredth anniversary of national independence. In addition to splendid July Fourth festivities, the Commission is examining ways to focus attention on the many and varied facets of Idaho's heritage. Publication of books, creation of regional parks and museums, and the encouragements of efforts to preserve the state's historic buildings are some of the activities now in the planning stages.
