

MALHEUR COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - January 3, 1973:
Court met with Judge Roy Hiral presiding, with Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

Howard Cockeram, County Roadmaster, presented the figure of \$360.00 for work done by the Road Department during the ice jam flood in the Annex area.

Procedure discussed for the drawing of the Jury list. Clerk's Office to prepare list and return to the Court to be checked for disqualifications.

Approved by Motion to transfer \$500.00 from Contingency Fund to the Road Department to cover expenses incurred by flood damage caused by the ice jam during December, 1972.

Bob Belknap will begin work in the County Shop servicing county cars on the 15th of January, 1973.

George Gurr, manager of the Bureau of Land Management, met with the Court requesting their attendance at the Advisory Board meeting, Wednesday, January 10, 1973 at 11:00 A.M.

Court requested Ray Huff, Sanitarian, to attend a meeting in Weiser, in regard to flood damage, at the A.C.S. Office, and report back to them.

Approved by Motion to designate the Argus Observer as the official paper, as it has the largest publication, with the Gate City Journal following second.

Approved by Motion to appoint Herbert Hartwell as Fiscal Budget Officer for 1973.

Approved by Motion to reappoint Bert Hawkins to the Budget Board for a period of three years. Decided to postpone the appointment of someone to fill the vacancy on the Budget Board by Ray Russell resigning, until the January 10, 1973 meeting.

Judge Hiral will act as liaison officer for the Court on the Parks and Recreation Committee.

Approved by Motion to appoint Sam Hartley as the liaison officer for the Court to the County-City Library Board.

Herbert Hartwell met with the Court concerning the Supplemental Budget. The Court approved a Budget hearing for January 31, 1973 at 9:00 A.M.

James Potter from Tudor Engineering Service was in to ask the Court to a meeting January 9, 1973, 8:00 P.M., for the purpose of applying for a grant for water for city sewage disposal.

Herbert Hartwell reported that there will be a decrease in Revenue Sharing monies to the county from the original figures. The maximum figure is \$116,747.00.

Court signed the Order Fixing the Date for Hearing in the Matter of the Dedication of a Road, beginning at a point where Cow Hollow Road intersects the Midsection Line.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - January 6, 1973:
Members of the Malheur County Court, Judge Hiral, Commissioners Maag and Hartley, Sheriff Robert G. Ingram, and District Attorney Frank Yraguen met in McDermitt, with Humboldt County Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, Ray Dufur, and Commissioner Pete L. Bengoechea, County Clerk, Grace Bell, Sheriff Leonard Clausen, District Attorney Bill MacDonald, Deputy Sheriff Robert Rothoff and other interested persons.

The meeting was to discuss the financial arrangements of hiring a deputy sheriff to work the border area of the counties. It was decided that Malheur County will supply one third of the monthly wage of \$600, with Humboldt County to supply two thirds of the wage, the auto, and it's upkeep, payroll costs, and bookkeeping. It was agreed that the deputy will get a \$50.00 per month raise at the end of six months period, starting from the date of employment for Humboldt County, December 1, 1972. The starting date of employment for Malheur County was January 8, 1973. Meeting adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - January 10, 1973:
Court met with Judge Roy Hiral presiding, with Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrected to read that the \$1,700.00 to be raised for the Comprehensive Health Planning Agency was for the County's share of the Operational Budget, not to build a wing on the Ontario Hospital.

Approved by Motion to accept the minutes as corrected.

The need of T.V. Comprehensive Health Planning Agency to obtain grant from Hill Burton funds to build wing on Holy Rosary Hospital was discussed. Mary Wakasugi is endeavoring to raise the \$1,700.00 for the budget by contributions.

Approved by Motion to give approval to Bureau of Reclamation for a grazing permit along Bully Creek Reservoir to Tom McElroy, Vale.

Letter from Assessor Oscar Bratton, was read in regard to Lola Steinke being appointed Deputy Assessor and Kenneth Saunders Chief Appraiser. Mrs. Steinke will stay at the same

pay scale and Mr. Saunders would raise to \$747.00 per month.

Judge Hiral read a letter from the state concerning the P.E.P. Program, in regard to the extension of the agreement and increase in funds. Herb Hartwell reported to the court that the statutes have been renewed on a monthly basis to February 20, 1973. Court agreed to employ 50 percent of P.E.P. employees at end of contract.

Wait Gillespie, County Surveyor, notified the Court that he was retiring as of April 1, 1973, but would be available for part time employment.

Meeting with BLM Advisory Board - Mr. Gurr advised the Court that the BLM would like the County to handle the money paid by users on A.U.M. basis, discretion of the Advisory Board. They would like as much money as possible kept on interest, and all bills such as salary payroll, power bills, gas, etc., paid by county. They reported there was approximately \$29,000.00 on hand in the County and approximately \$28,000.00 in the Federal Treasury in Denver.

Court met with Nancy Moore and Lola Steinke in regard to updating the Job Classification and Salary Survey book.

Judge Hiral is to write a letter to all Department Heads inviting them to submit recommendations for improvement of Survey Book by February 14, 1973. Would like to have committee of Department Heads and Employees take recommendations to District Attorney, Frank Yraguen.

Approved by Motion to direct Pat Bond to accept the Planning and Zoning fees, to be placed in the General County Fund.

Approved by Motion that Judge Hiral be appointed liaison officer to the Fair Board for the County Court.

Court will attend COG meeting in Burns on January 11, 1973.

Order No. 15 approved. In the Matter of Payment of Claims, hereby ordering the County Auditor to issue warrants in the amount of \$80,022.48.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - January 17, 1973:
Court met with Judge Roy Hiral presiding, with Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

Howard Cockeram presented the Court with a salary increase request from the Road Department secretary Debbie DeLong. Approved by Motion to upgrade her salary one step.

The Minutes were read and corrected to have Employees bring salary revisions to the Court first, so that they may be kept informed, and then to the District Attorney.

Judge Hiral called Don Kudrna, of the FHA about flooding condition in Jordan Valley. He reported that the FHA had monies to loan for the purpose of cleaning channels or building dams to control water.

The maximum loan would be \$10,000.00 per person.

Herb Hartwell recommended that Mrs. Alberta DeLong be paid travel and day pay from the Petit Jury Fund. Approved by Motion to pay Alberta DeLong from the Petit Jury Fund.

Preparing the priorities on the Revenue Sharing Funds budget, the Supplemental Revenue Sharing Funds for the 1973-74 Budget and the Budget for Revenue Sharing Funds for 1973-74 funds were discussed by the Court.

Court met with Wilbur and Jim Atherton, who have contract to care for dogs for the county and cities. They presented a summary of what they are doing and the problems they have encountered, and petitioned the Court to sell dog licenses through their business.

Mary Ellen Nelson reported that the County has contributed in excess of \$12,000.00 toward the Migrant Health Fund.

Court adjourned until 1:00 P.M. January 18, 1973.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - January 18, 1973:
John Edwards and Jim Atkins met with the Court. The following problems were discussed:

1. Need for security room to hold mentally disturbed persons.

2. State wants Mental Health to investigate drug problems, and screening by Mental Health Director before commitment of mentally ill person.

3. This year budget for the Family Service Clinic has been planned so it will not exceed 6 percent limitation. They have asked for \$1,500.00 for office space and \$1,500.00 for a security room from Revenue Sharing monies.

Approved by Motion to put one Sheriff's car up for bid.

Approved by Motion to send a Resolution thanking our representatives for voting for the Revenue Sharing bill, to them.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - January 23, 1973:
Court met with Judge Roy Hiral, presiding, with Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

Herb Hartwell stated that he had put the freeze on 9 hospital beds that were available for 35 percent off, at a cost of \$126.00

per bed. Approved by Motion to purchase the hospital beds, providing there is money in the budget.

Court met on Tuesday and Thursday to make plans on budget for Revenue Sharing money.

Letter read in regard to swimming area at Bully Creek Park, placing of signs, etc. Court is to accept recommendations of Agency, by Mr. James A. Hubert.

Approved by Motion that the Court pay \$335.00 of the Civil Defense Matching Fund for a radio.

Approved by Motion to pay annual dues to the Public Lands Association in the amount of \$35.00.

Approved by Motion that Judge Hiral order locks and keys for the Courthouse doors and be the keeper of all keys.

Approved by Motion to appoint John Bishop to replace Hilton Clark on the Planning and Zoning Committee, whose terms will expire February 1, 1976.

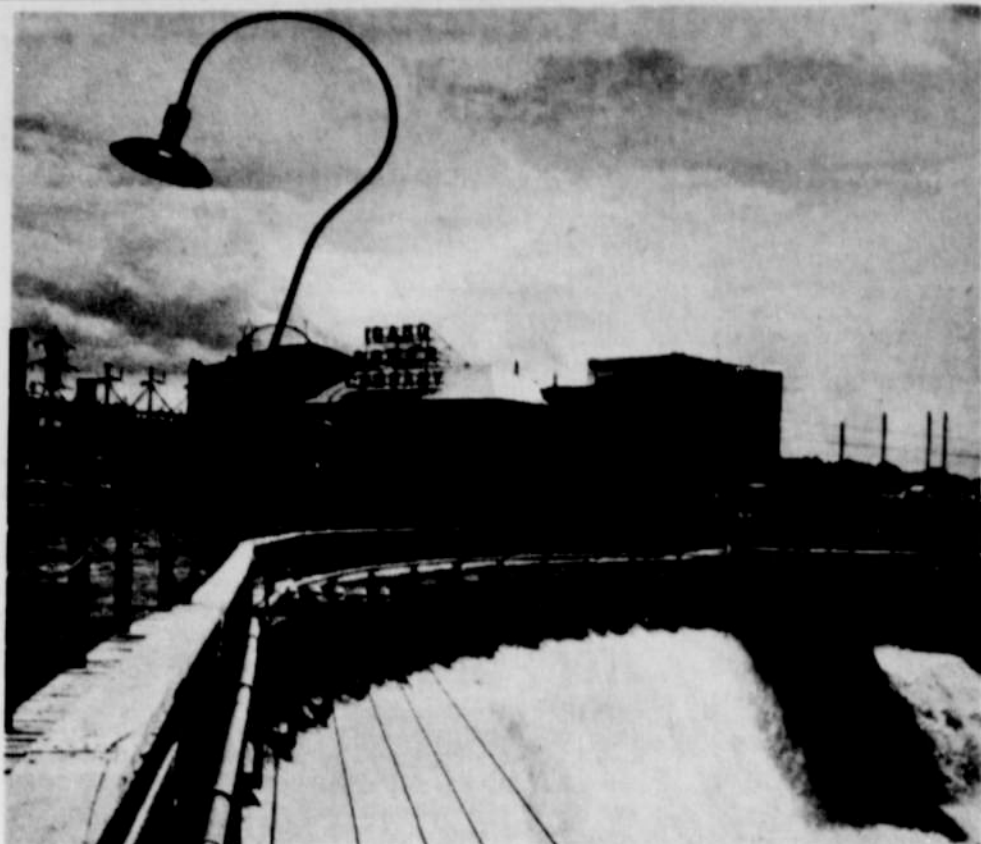
