Solid Waste Meeting Tonight at Ontario

Ugly, smelly dumps which are environmentally detrimental and a public health hazard will soon be a thing of the past. Are garbage collection rates going to increase? Will private citizens still be able to drive to the local landfill and dump their own garbage? Or will the local landfills be closed and only one regional site be operating by 1975? Are residents of the area going to be required to separate glass, metal and newspaper and other recyclable materials for salvage collectors?

A county-wide planning program to determine the answers to these questions and others concerning solid waste management is about to begin in Malheur County and will be discussed at a public information meeting in Ontario on Thursday, April 26, at 7:30 p.m., at the Ontario City-County Library, 3885 S.W. 2nd Avenue.

The public meeting which comes early in the planning stages for solid waste reuse and disposal in Malheur County is aimed at informing the public of the goals of the solid waste management plan which is currently being developed and providing an opportunity for citizens to discuss problems, suggest new programs or criticize the suggested planning goals. The meeting will be conducted by members of the local solid waste advisory committee, local persons involved in solid waste management planning, representatives of the state advisory committee and Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

Speaking to the Consumer

"WHEELING AND DEALING" Before making the final "deal" on a new car, the wise consumer will have the following information in hand: (1) the approximate value of the trade-in car, (2) the suggested retail price of several similar autos and their optional equipment, and (3) the cost of financing through at least two sources. Banks, credit unions, finance companies, and magazines specializing in automobile reporting can help the consumer gather this information. With it, the new car buyer is better able to make dollar judgments when the dealer says, "I can offer you a trade of..."

INVESTIGATIVE CONSUMER REPORTS. Under the Fair Credit Reporting Act, insurance companies-like financing companies-must inform you that an "investigative consumer report" may be prepared in connection with your policy application. They must tell you that the information will be obtained through personal interviews with your friends, neighbors and associates and will report such items as your character, general reputation, personal characteristics and mode of living. As a consumer, you have a right to know that the investigation will take place and that you can learn what is included in the "investigative consumer report" by making a written request to the insurance company involved.
