

# COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 1, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

Approved by Motion to allow Extension Service to buy 3 typewriters and a mimeograph machine out of Extension Service travel expense funds in this year's budget.

Approved by Motion to pay for Land Use Book preparation, in the amount of \$211.74, to be paid out of Planning Commission funds.

Emil Maag reported on the Law Enforcement Emergency Commission meeting, January 31, 1973. The Communication Committee plan to set 10 percent, per year, aside for emergency repair.

The Court checked the jury list for Circuit Court Duty. Revenue Sharing Funds: Court approved County Clerk's request for \$5,800.00 for office fixtures and microfilm equipment.

Court approved \$5,000.00 for Parks and Recreation. Court approved Auditor's Budget as requested. Court approved the Juvenile Department Budget, as requested.

Court approved Tax Department Budget, as requested. The Court approved the request to buy 11 cars for the county.

Court approved \$3,480.00 for the Malheur Nursing Home. Court approved \$3,900.00 for an ambulance and \$7,500.00 for a surgical light, for the Nyssa Memorial Hospital.

The Road Districts will be allocated their proportionate share. Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 6, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding, and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

Court met with the Budget Board regarding Revenue Sharing Budget.

Approved by Motion to appoint Joe Hobson to replace Ray Russell's unexpired term on the Budget Board.

The Budget Board and Court discussed the Revenue Sharing Budget for -1972 through 12-30-72.

The Assessor's Office original proposal of \$2,500.00 was increased by \$400.00 to buy an electric typewriter. Total Budget \$2,900.00.

The Circuit Court capital outlay was increased from \$400.00 to \$700.00.

The Clerk's Office Budget stayed the same, \$5,800.00. The Health Department Budget was increased from \$1,500.00 to \$1,750.00.

The Ontario Justice Court was given the requested amount of \$1,000.00.

Vale Justice Court asked for \$4,000.00 and was decreased to \$500.00 for needed office space.

The Juvenile Department was given the \$150.00 asked for to buy a tape recorder and typewriter stand.

The Malheur County Library budget was decreased from \$6,800.00 to \$5,925.00.

The Malheur Memorial Hospital was given funds in the amount of \$11,400.00 to buy a used ambulance and operating room emergency light.

The Malheur Nursing Home Budget was decreased from \$46,000.00 to \$3,480.00 for Mattresses and cubicle curtains, with more to be budgeted for the home later. \$5,000.00 was budgeted for capital outlay on Parks and Recreation.

The Sheriff's Department Budget was decreased from \$13,880.00 to a balance of \$9,605.00 (transfer of new car for Sheriff's Department to County Court Budget.)

\$55,000.00 for a used Caterpillar (D-7) with 750 hours, to be used for Solid Waste was budgeted.

The County Road Department was budgeted \$31,500.00 for capital outlay, and material and supplies in the amount of \$53,576.00, for each district as follows:

Dist. No. 3 13,910.00

Dist. No. 4 5,970.00

Dist. No. 5 4,770.00

County Road 45,008.00

\$85,076.00

Major Bridges, material and supplies, \$15,014.00

\$3,500.00 was budgeted for a coordinator and \$1,500.00 for

material and supplies for Planning and Zoning. This was cut from the original request of \$10,000.00.

The Budget Board allowed \$2,000.00 for extra help for the custodian.

Capital Outlay for the Courthouse of \$365.00 for a floor polisher, \$1,250.00 for a postage meter machine and \$40,275.00 for replacement of 12 automobiles.

A contingency fund of \$3,811.00 was set up.

Approved by Motion to delete \$1,500.00 for the security room, from the family Service Clinic Budget.

Approval by Motion of the budget with the changes that have been noted.

Judge Roy Hirai proposed that the Assessor's Office hire Charles Gehley at the original wage offered, and pay \$144.00 out of the Assessor's Travel Budget for Mr. Gehley's moving expenses.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 7, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding, and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

Court is to make a list of the jurors released from jury duty and enter in the Court minutes.

The minutes through February 1, 1973, were read and approved.

Court approved county bills for January 31, and February 7, 1973.

Court met with Lloyd Bone, Solid Waste Consultant from Bakersfield, California, who would like to help the County with the Solid Waste Grant.

At the Planning and Zoning meeting in Jordan Valley, Jordan Valley residents voted to zone the area there, general.

Court held a hearing on the vacation of the Easterday Road in Jordan Valley.

Approved by Motion to instruct Jean Bond, Treasurer, to pay tax refunds to Thayer Cattle Co., in the amount of \$29.89, Allen Fletcher, \$502.30, Carroll Looney, \$1,041.08, Donald Oakes, \$1,487.29 and Bert Hawkins, \$14.21.

Approved Order No. 18, in the Matter of Payment of Claims, hereby ordering the County Auditor to issue warrants totaling \$14,741.55.

Order excusing Jurors, signed by the Court.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 13, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

Court met with George Gurr, Manager, Shelton Saxton, in charge of Right of Ways, and Fritz Rennebaum, in charge of Central Resource Area, of the Bureau of Land Management, and W.E. Gillespie, concerning the recreation area at Antelope Reservoir.

The BLM is to meet with the District Attorney and W.E. Gillespie to establish sites, and right of ways for access roads.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 14, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding, and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

The minutes were read, corrected and approved.

Court wishes to go on record as opposing HB 5021, for the transfer of Marine Funds from the county to the State Police.

Approved by Motion to pay bills for the Planning & Zoning Commission.

Approved by Motion to pay bill to Homedale Highway District in the amount of \$250.00. Also renew present agreement with the Homedale District and express our appreciation for work done.

Approved by Motion to pay for a one year subscription to the Revenue Sharing Bulletin in the amount of \$25.00.

Approved by Motion to pay the Malheur Home Telephone bill in the amount of \$48.76.

The Court held a hearing on the Dedication of Cow Hollow Road. As no one appeared to object to the dedication of the road, the Court declared the road to be on the county road system.

Court approved the appointment of Councilman, Ralph Cornmesser, to

represent the City of Ontario as a member of the Malheur Solid Waste Council.

The Court is to write a letter to the state representatives in opposition to HB 5021, regarding limits of bi-annual expenditures of fees and monies or other revenues collected by the State Marine Board. (1,176,927.00)

Court reviewed the Law Enforcement Contract with Humboldt County.

Order No. 19 Approved, in the Matter of Payment of Claims, hereby ordering the County Auditor to issue warrants totaling \$21,549.40.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 15, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding, and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

The cities petitioned the Court to increase the fee charged for dog licenses to \$5.00 for both male and female dogs, and for the authority to enforce the dogs running at large law, within the cities.

The monthly increase of wages for the Atherton Kennels was agreed upon by the County, and cities of Vale, Ontario and Nyssa. The wage of \$750.00 per month is to be divided as follows:

Ontario 39 percent  
Nyssa 31 percent  
Vale 16 percent  
County 14 percent

The new wage of \$750 will start at the beginning of the fiscal year.

The County will receive \$21,173.57 in BOR funds. Ontario has requested \$25,500.00 of BOR funds, so they have asked COG to try to borrow funds from other counties, so they will have the required funds to complete their park. Vale is not requesting any money this year, but would like to have \$3,000.00 next year. The County has agreed to use some BOR funds to help improve the parks and boat ramps at Owyhee Dam State Parks.

City Manager Jack Collins suggested that the incorporated cities and the county meet once a month to discuss problems that they have in common. It was decided to meet the 3rd Thursday of each month at 11:00 A.M. in different cities.

Court approved of Rural Assessment District No. 3's appointment of Merle Maine to the Solid Waste Council.

Larry Bauman met with the Court requesting that Nyssa be able to continue to use the Lyle Dump, in the event that they dispose of their present dump site.

Court adjourned.

Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - February 21, 1973: Court met with Judge Roy Hirai presiding and Commissioner E. W. Maag present. Commissioner Sam Hartley absent.

Minutes were read and approved.

Pat Bond presented the Court with a recap of taxes refunded to people who overpaid.

Court discussed BLM Notice of the meeting March 7, in Ontario, of the regulations for off road vehicles. George Gurr stated that BLM would put out publicity on the meeting.

Court met with Al Gaschler concerning the plat for the Nelson Addition to be annexed into the City of Ontario. The Court would like to have Mr. Gaschler present the plat at the County Planning and Zoning meeting, for their approval, since until the land is annexed, it is still under county planning.

Ray Huff stated that he had called a meeting of the newly formed Solid Waste Council for Monday night, February 26, at 7:30 P.M. in the County Courthouse.

Bob Harrod from the IED office presented the Court with an agreement with the Law Education Agency to be signed.

Approved Order No. 20, in the Matter of Payment of Claims, hereby ordering the County Auditor to issue warrants totaling \$12,384.64.

Court adjourned.
