6th Grade Outdoor Trip Scheduled May 3 & 4

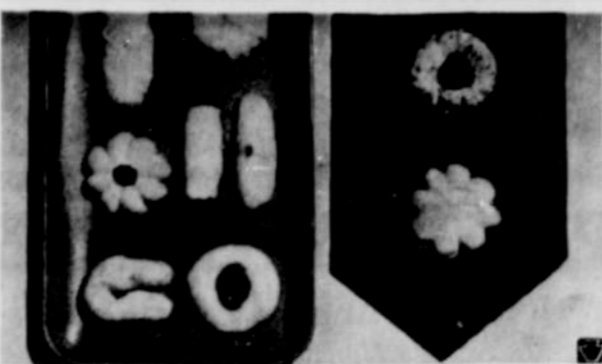
The Sixth Grade Outdoor Education Tour has been scheduled for May 3rd and 4th, according to Ron Mobley, Malheur Extension Agent. Activities have been scheduled at two sites, Lytle Boulevard and Owyhee River. Range and soils will be studied at Lytle, while geology and fisheries and wildlife will be observed at the Owyhee site. A change in procedure has been instituted this year. In the past resource people have conducted a major portion of the on-station instruction. This year each teacher will lead his class through each exercise.

At the Lytle site the teachers will lead their classes through the on-station investigation, then assemble for large group debriefing by the resource men. The soils debriefing will be done by Frank Noll of the Vale Bureau of Land Management, while Phil Rumpel, also of the BLM, will conduct the range assembly. At the Owyhee area Lowell Dean of Treasure Valley Community College will debrief the geology section. The wildlife and fisheries station will be conducted with an assembly first, followed by the investigative tour. Dan Briscoe of the BLM and Kin Daily of the Oregon State Game Commission will conduct the wildlife and fisheries assembly.

If the tour happens to be cancelled because of bad weather, it will not be re-scheduled because the 3rd and 4th are the only dates available for providing this service by all the resource people involved.

We are indebted to the Oregon State Game Commission, Bureau of Land Management, Soil Conservation Service, and Malheur Extension Service for making the Outdoor Tour possible.

Cookies Galore from One Recipe

A good cookie recipe that can be adapted to make several different varieties, is an invaluable aid to any family. Nuts, jelly, chocolate and coconut - each of these can be used to make a different cookie from this basic dough.

All Purpose Cookie
 1/2 cup corn starch
 1/2 cup confectioners sugar
 1 cup sifted flour
 1/2 cup margarine

Sift corn starch, sugar and flour together into mixing bowl. Stir in margarine, mixing until soft dough forms. Shape, as desired. Place about 1 1/2 inches apart on ungreased baking sheet. Bake in a 300°F oven about 20 minutes until edges are lightly browned. Makes 2 to 3 dozen cookies. Variations: Form cookies with a press; or shape by hand into balls, rolls or crescents. Roll in chopped nuts before baking; or, after baking, dip cookie into melted chocolate or dust with confectioners sugar. For thumb print cookies, make a depression in centers of cookie balls before baking. After baking, fill depressions with jelly. For Double Decker Cookies, press dough into 8-inch square pan and bake 40 minutes. Sprinkle with 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate pieces and place in oven just until chocolate melts. Spread chocolate evenly. Sprinkle with 1/2 cup flaked coconut and cut into 12 squares.
