KIDS' COMMERCIALS. Tele-vision commercials in chil-dren's programs have deli-gated the kids and frustrated the parents. Budget-conscious adults know all too well the power of child's persuasion.

The National Association of Broadcasters has taken steps to decrease commercials broad-cast during children's pro-gramming. After January 1, 1973, stations participating in the association's "Television Code" will allow only 12 minutes of commercials in any one hour instead of the current 16.

Since this change comes after the holiday season and affects only the quantity, not the quality, of ads, parents would be wise to think ahead and decide before the Christmas gift-giving season how they will handle their child's television-inspired persuasion.

MAJOR APPLIANCE PRICE LEVELS

A shopping principle to help you get the most from your major appliance dollar is re-membering that most merchan-dise falls into three classi-fications---low-end, moderate price, and deluxe. While the low-end may offer only the "basics," the deluxe frequently has the same features as the moderate priced, but with more refinement and automation. By looking at models within each classification, you can make better decisions about what is important to your needs and the cost you are willing to pay for time-saving and convenience features.

BUYING LAWN SEED. A truth-in-labeling law for lawn seed requires that the package shows the kinds of seed in-cluded; the amount of inert matter, weed seeds, and other-crop seeds; and the germination rate the seed had when it was tested. Use this label information as your guide to quality.

For help in determining what kind of seed will work best on your soil, in sun or shade, and for the amount of foot traf-fic you anticipate, contact the Oregon State University Ex-tension Agent in your county office.

TRAVEL TIPS. Families planning a spring trip to a winter resort area, hoping to get in on off-season rates, should be particularly alert this year. Many resort motels are extend-ing their regular rates into May and not putting off-season rates into effect as early as usual. Families also will want to get a clear understanding about whether or not young chil-dren are included free in the room rate. On the road, bud-get motel chains offer eco-nomical sleeping quarters for families not concerned about special services, color TV, swimming pools, and luxurious restaurant facilities.
