



OREGON'S BEEF INDUSTRY LEADERS graphically demonstrate that a day's wage today will buy over one and a half times the amount of choice beef that the same eight hours work day would buy more than 20 years ago. On the left, OBC Chairman William Marshall, Klamath Falls, indicates that in 1952 a day's wage would buy 14.4 lbs of beef. On the right, Cattlemen's Association president C.M. Otley, Diamond, shows that a day's wage in 1973 will buy 23.3 lbs of beef. Center Oregon CowBelle President, Mrs. William Loeppig, Haines, depicts the increase of 8.8 lbs. more beef for today's wage earners than 20 years ago.

This graphic demonstration was presented by the Oregon Beef Industry to students at Portland State University last week, during a discussion on food and beef prices. (Statistics from U.S. Department of Labor.)
