ASK SEN. PACKWOOD

QUESTION: My husband and I recently purchased a \$10 Golden Eagle Passport which we thought would allow us unlimited entry into Oregon parks this summer. But when we went to Diamond Lake Park, no one would accept it. We met a lot of other people at the gate in our same predicament. What's the story?

—Lebanon

ANSWER: Unfortunately, the law governing the Golden Eagle Program was changed last year, but the name of the program was not. In Oregon, under the new law, the Golden Eagle Passport can only be used for entry into Crater Lake National Park, and it does not entitle you to any discounts for recreation fees within the Park. The Golden Eagle Passport, however, can be used at 50 other National Parks across the country. The Golden Age Passport works differently, and I think the similarity in names has caused some confusion. The Golden Age Passport is issued free to persons 62 or older. It entitles the holder to a 50 percent discount on all federal special recreation use fees, such as camping or boat-launching charges, in addition to free entry. This passport is honored by seven federal agencies, and this would include Forest Service parks as well as National parks and other public recreation lands.

QUESTION: With meat prices as high as they are, I think it would be cheaper to buy a side of beef to freeze. What kind of advice does the government have for me?

—Portland

ANSWER: For a discussion of how to compare meat prices and make sure that you are getting a good value, you might want to order a Department of Agriculture bulletin titled "How To Buy Meat For Your Freezer." It is available free on postcard request from the Office of Information, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D.C. 20250. The bulletin also tells you how to buy lamb and pork, and gives details of the types cuts you can expect from a side or quarter of meat.
