

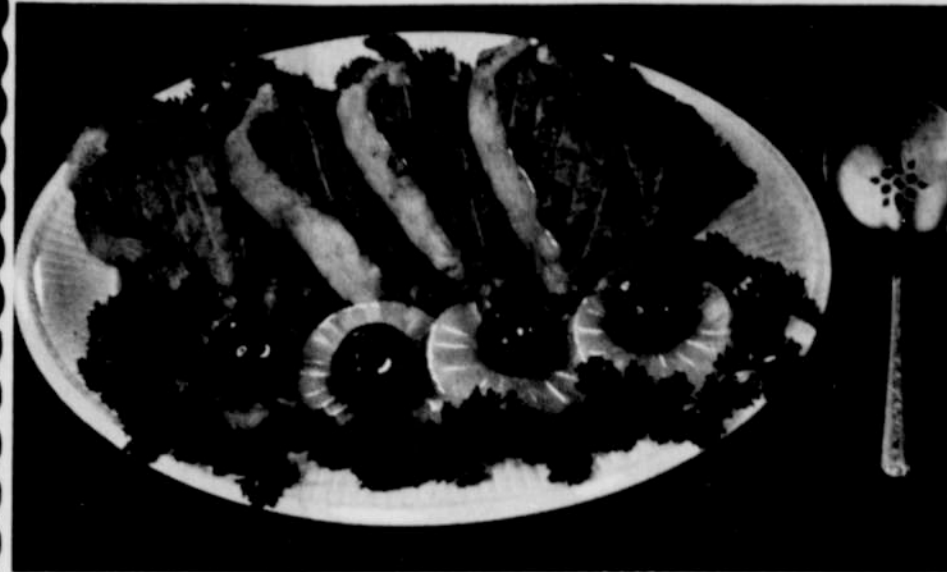

New Shopping Complex
An unusual shopping complex, designed to serve the same varied functions as a classic old-world market, will open in Kansas City, Mo., late this summer.

The retailing area, covering 400,000 square feet of the privately financed \$200-million Crown Center, will include a large three-story specialty store, a Farmers' Market featuring food and wines sold from stalls; a 450-seat Cafe Internationale serving seven types of cuisine; 60 individual retail


shops selling everything from clothing, bicycles and antiques to tropical fish and children's shoes; an ice-skating rink, beauty salon and art gallery; and a totally new shopping idea—a multi-level series of miniature boutiques housed in 12-by-12 foot steel cubes, each offering specialized merchandise such as dolls, belts or mountain gear.

Favorite Foods

I wrote an article about Strawberry Pie last week so thought I'd add to your Strawberry file and tell you of a Strawberry Cake I make and relish. It's similar to the Lemon Cake and may be assembled quicker than quick. A cake mix is responsible for this.

1 cup mashed banana
1-3/4 cups quick rolled oats, uncooked
1 cup raisins, if desired
Fat to grease baking sheet.
Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
Mix flour, sugar, baking soda, and salt in a large bowl. Mix in fat with a pastry blender, fork or two knives until finely crumbled. Stir egg and rest of ingredients all at once into flour mixture. Beat well. Grease baking sheet. Drop dough by teaspoons onto baking sheet. Leave about two inches between cookies so they can "spread out" during baking. Bake about twelve minutes.

STRAWBERRY CAKE
1-10 1/2 oz. pkg frozen strawberries
1 package strawberry gelatin
3/4 cup boiling water
2 tablespoons strawberry juice
1-lb. 2 oz. pkg white cake mix
3/4 cup corn oil
4 eggs.
Thaw strawberries and place in a strainer. Dissolve strawberry gelatin in boiling water. When cool, add 2 tablespoons of the strawberry juice. Pour cake mix into large bowl of electric mixer. Add corn oil and gelatin. Beat until smooth. Add eggs, one at a time, beating 4 minutes in all.
Pour into a 9x12x2 greased baking pan and bake 35 to 40 minutes at 350 degree oven.

BANANA OATMEAL COOKIES
1-1/2 cups unsifted flour
1 cup sugar
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
1 teaspoon salt
3/4 cup shortening
1 Egg, beaten

Ag Specialists To Visit

Eleven foreign agricultural credit specialists will start a three week study of Farmers Home Administration activities in Oregon when they arrive in Ontario on July 8th it was announced by K.W. Sawyer, State Director.
The specialists hope to adapt for use in their own countries the supervised credit practices of FHA, The U.S. Department of Agriculture's rural credit service.
The group, representing Vietnam, Ghana, Iran and Kenya, will be accompanied to Oregon by Jack Hartman, foreign nationals representative from the agency's Washington, D.C. headquarters.
Mr. Sawyer said the foreign visitors are studying agricultural credit in the United States under sponsorship of the Agency for International Development. All are recognized authorities and private or government officials in their home countries.
This week the group will meet with state officials responsible for directing the FHA program in Oregon. They will study the administrative skills needed to make the agency's supervised credit program function smoothly.
The week of July 15th, the specialists will be at Pendleton, where they will study real estate loans and credit assistance to rural groups.
The following week they go to Portland to review state office operations and participate in round table discussions of the possible adaptations of FHA policies and methods for use in their own countries.
