BABE RUTH PLAYERS LEAVE FOR PORTLAND

Locally, the Babe Ruth baseball season is over, but three local youngsters left Wednesday, July 25, for an added week of play as members of the Snake River Valley All Star team. Joe Joyce and Bill Marcum of Nyssa and Brendon Pratt, Adrian, will be playing the state Babe Ruth tournament in Portland. The week-long tournament will be a double-elimination affair and the winner will represent the state in the national tournament in Vancouver British Columbia later in the summer.

Stampede Gives Results

A chico, Texas calf roper who last year ranked fifth in the nation had a pretty good week at the 58th annual Snake River Stampede which ended Saturday night in Nampa.

Ronny Sewalt, presently in the seventh spot nationally, was the rodeo's high money winner, collecting \$1715 for less than a half-minute's work while besting the efforts of six other top-rated ropers including national leader Ernie Taylor of Hugo, Oklahoma.

Sewalt got his two calves tied in 22 seconds flat. Second highest money winner was Bobby Bean of Okemah, Oklahoma with totals of 10 seconds flat on two and \$1574 in steer wrestling.

Ace Berry of Modesto, Calif., had the highest aggregate score--152 points--on two bareback broncs and took home \$1277. Berry is third in Rodeo Cowboys Associations standings.

In the one-round bull riding contest second-ranked Bobby Stelner of Austin, Texas, earned \$1206 with a 75 point, first place effort.

Two cowboys tied for the top spot in saddle bronc riding. Bobby Berger of Norman, Okla., and J. C. Bonine of Hysham, Montana, each totaled 144 points on a pair of broncs. Berger won \$1057; Third-ranked, Bonine claimed \$1157.

The total Stampede payoff was \$21,025.
