**WATER SYSTEM CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NYSSA**

Shall the City of Nyssa charter be amended by adding a new chapter authorizing construction of a supplemental water and distribution system in addition to the present system, including sinking wells, construction of a water storage tank, installation of pumps, pipelines and other essential equipment, acquisition of sites, easements and rights of way for said system, issuance and sale of general obligation bonds not exceeding \$425,000.00 therefor, authorizing pledging all or part of net revenues of said system and authorizing tax levy in sufficient amount to pay principal and interest of said bonds whenever necessary to supplement available water revenues?

## ASK SEN. PACKWOOD

**QUESTION:** I'm scared to death my veterans pension will be cut back because of the recent increase in social security benefits. I am a crippled widow and have had a bad stroke, and my medical bills run about \$2,000 a year. I'm too young for Medicare. What am I going to live on?

**ANSWER:** It is possible your veterans pension could be reduced, but the amount of the reduction should be smaller than the social security benefit increase. Under improvements made in the veterans pension law in 1971, you are generally assured that your total income will not be reduced. The Senate attempted to pass a bill last year that would have given you the increased social security benefits without reducing your veterans pension, but the House of Representatives did not act on the measure. On a more encouraging note — if you have been receiving social security disability benefits for two years or more, you may be eligible for Medicare, regardless of your age. This is a new provision of the social security law which will go into effect in July 1973.

**QUESTION:** I read the other day that the Chinese are costing the United Nations an extra \$5 million a year for transcription and translation services. Why do they merit so much money?

**ANSWER:** The United Nations did not appropriate an extra \$5 million, but it did appropriate \$688,000 to increase the capacity of Chinese language services. Chinese has been one of the five working languages in the United Nations since its inception in 1945, and Chinese delegates have always been entitled to simultaneous interpretation of speeches and translation of documents. The Republic of China, however, did not press for extensive translations and often used English in meetings. When the Peoples' Republic of China was seated in the UN in 1971, it was clearly indicated that the Chinese delegation would no longer forego the full use of the Chinese language. Therefore, the UN General Assembly voted the increased funds for this purpose.
