Court signed an Amended Order describing land to be sold at the July 20, 1973 County Land Sale.

An Order from the Circuit Court to the County Court and Budget Committee to pay Donna Calhoun \$527.50 per month, for the fiscal year 1973-1974, was read by the Court. This was ordered on June 1, 1973. The Budget Committee denied the order and designated the county pay a salary of \$458.00 per month.

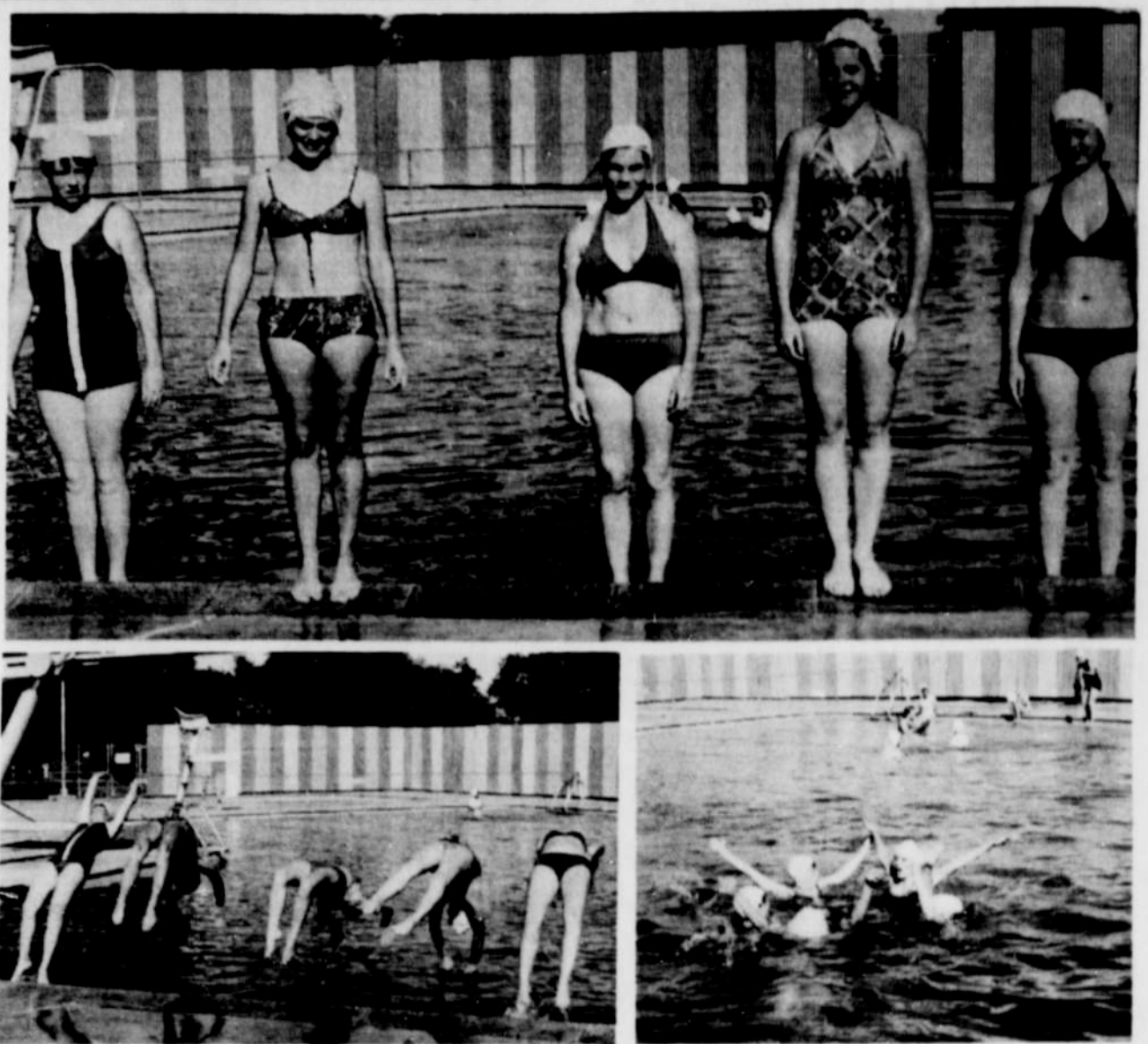
