PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, at a special elec-tion held in the City of Nyssa on the 10th day of September, 1973, there was submitted to the legal voters of said City of Nyssa the proposition of adop-tion of a proposed amend-ment to the Charter of the City of Nyssa by adding thereto a new chapter authorizing the Common Council of said City of Nyssa to construct a supplemental water and distribution system, in addition to the present system, including sinking wells, con-struction of a water storage tank, installation of pumps, pipes and other essential equip-ment, acquisition of sites, ease-ments and rights of way for said system, issuance and sale of general obligation bonds not exceeding \$425,000 therefor, au-thorizing pledging all or part of net revenues of said system and authorizing tax levy in suf-ficient amount to pay principal and interest of said bonds when-ever necessary to supplement available water revenues; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said special election have been duly filed with the City Rec-ord and have been duly canvased and examined by the Com-mon Council of the City of Nyssa; and

WHEREAS, it appears that a total of 169 ballots were cast at said special election on said proposition, and that 147 bal-lots were cast in favor of the proposition and were marked "500 x Yes," that 22 ballots were cast against the propo-sition and marked "501 x No," and that a majority of said votes cast were cast in favor of the adoption of said amendment to the Charter of the City of Nyssa.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Larry A. Bauman, Mayor of the City of Nyssa, do hereby proclaim that the proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Nyssa, as submitted to the legal voters of the City of Nyssa, pursuant to Resolution No. 286 adopted the 14th day of August, 1973, has been approved by the legal voters of the City of Nyssa and does become effective as of the close of said election on the said 10th day of Sep-tember, 1973.
