**Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - September 5, 1973:** Court met with Judge Roy Hiral presiding and Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

Approved by Motion to transfer \$3,020.00 from Contingency Fund to the Sheriff Department, Special Deputy Budget.

Approved by Motion to raise the base rate at the Malheur Nursing Home to \$13.00 per day, to conform with Welfare rates.

Approved by Motion to inform Atherton Kennels that the dog licenses will be on an annual basis from January, and that all licenses sold from now to January 1st, will be \$5.00.

Ivan Patrick and Jim Grant have agreed to be co-chairman for the Bi-Centennial for Oregon. Frank Quenlin will meet with the Court and co-chairman, September 11, at 10:30 A.M.

Approved by Motion to pay Phillis Pressley 1/2 of \$386.00 per month, for work in the Treasurer Office as Deputy Treasurer I. As Mrs. Pressley was paid on a 1/2 of \$175.00 basis in August, the difference is to be adjusted on her September check.

Approved by Motion to the Riverside Grocery, Kenneth & Marie Rhodes, Weiser, Idaho.

A copy of the 1971-72 contract with the Fair Board was read, for the rental of the Commercial Building for the Abundant Food use. It was agreed to renew the contract on the basis of rent, 6c per square foot for \$430.00 per month.

The County Court proclaimed Saturday, September 8, as Nancy Jackson, Miss Oregon Day. Court adjourned.

**Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - September 13, 1973:**

County Court met at 4:00 P.M., with Judge Roy Hiral presiding and Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

The State Health Department will be here to meet with the court on the 26th of September and the Department of Environmental Quality, the first part of October, in regard to inspection of restaurants and sewers.

Court resolved to hire Alfred Pottorff as the County Planner, at a salary of \$557.00, with a raise in 6 months, if he qualifies.

Court adjourned.

**Minutes of the Malheur County Court Meeting - September 19, 1973:**

Court met with Judge Roy Hiral presiding and Commissioners E.W. Maag and Sam Hartley present.

Approved by Motion to hire Ralph Metcalf, as Service Man in the County Road Shop, at a wage of \$3.21 per hour, making him ineligible for a raise in six months, as he is not starting on the first step.

Approved by Motion to purchase two Giedhill snow plows, No. 10 at \$1,578.39 each, plus \$130.00 freight each. As there were no other bids, they are being purchased from Scarborough in

Portland, and are to be paid for from Revenue Sharing funds.

Kenneth Romans brought the Court \$5,625.00 to oil 6th Avenue for 2 1/2 miles, from the people who live on this road. The road will be oiled in 1974.

The Court agreed to hire Geoff Seymour on a full time basis, with monthly probation, at a starting salary of \$458.00 and an increase in 6 months to \$481.00 if it works out satisfactorily.

Approved by Motion that the County Court sign the bond, in the amount of \$1,000.00, to cover reimbursement of the advertising involved in forming of the Nursing Home District, if the people do not approve.

Approved by Motion to tentatively approve the Solid Waste project as submitted to the Court by Bruce Sarazin.

Approved by Motion to hire another nurse, Gay Morinaka, for 10 months, at a salary of \$614.00 per month, providing Health Department Clinics would not be held at the Multi-Service Center in Nyssa.

The Court approved the use of a county car by Miss Morinaka, with the reimbursement of 8 cents a mile to the county.

Approved by Motion to pay Alfred Pottorff a salary of \$557.00 with a raise to \$585.00 in six months if he is satisfactory, for the Planner position.

Approved by Motion to resubmit the bid on the Sheriff car along with the two pickups for the Road Department, to the car dealers.

The Interim Head Start Board for the Child Development Center has been formed, and will hold their first meeting September 20th.

Court adjourned.
