INVITATION TO BID

SEALED PROPOSALS FOR THE construction of water system improvements, 1974, addressed to Honorable Mayor and City Council, will be received at the office of the City Manager, City Hall, Nyssa, Oregon, until 8:00 P.M. local time, on the 11th Day of December 1973 and then will be publicly opened and read.

The work contemplated consists of construction of a 3 million gallon steel reservoir, complete, booster pump station complete with 2 vertical turbine pumps, pipe valves and fittings, metering system, an electrical control system, and construction of approximately 1,200 linear feet of 16-inch transmission pipeline.

Plans and specifications may be examined in the office of City Manager, City Hall, Nyssa, Oregon, or at the office of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, Engineers-Planners-Economists, 414 North First Street, Boise, Idaho 83701. A copy of said documents may be obtained at the Engineer's office upon a deposit of \$25 for each document. The full amount of the deposit will be refunded if said documents are returned in good condition within 10 days after bidding opens.

Bidders must be prequalified in compliance with applicable parts of Chapter 279 of Oregon Revised Statutes, Oregon State Standard Prequalifications Forms, if needed, may be obtained from the Engineer. These forms, completely filled out, should be submitted to City Recorder, City Hall, Nyssa, Oregon at least 10 days prior to the bidding date. The owner will issue proposal forms to qualified bidders.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form, payable to the City of Nyssa, Oregon in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a bond for faithful performance of the contract in the full amount of the contract price.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to postpone the Award of the contract for a period not to exceed 30 days, and to accept that proposal which is to the best interests of the City of Nyssa, Oregon.
