## Bomb Scare At Payette

Payette students had an unexpected half-day off from their studies Monday as the result of a telephoned bomb threat.

The threat was the second received by the Payette School District during the day. The first call threatening a bomb came at 8:21 a.m. to the Payette County sheriff's office where a deputy answering the phone was informed "there's a bomb in the high school and it's going to go off."

School officials evacuated the building of about 500 students while officers from both the sheriff's office and the Payette Police Department searched the building. Deputies said no bomb was found.

Students were dismissed at about 12:30 p.m. Monday when an unidentified caller told a school employee in the high school office that a bomb would go off at 3:30 p.m. School officials decided to call it a day for all school district students because the caller had neglected to designate which school was being threatened. Searchers again found no bomb.
